





Graduate School of SJTU

Shanghai Jiao Tong University (SJTU) began to offer post-graduate education in 1931, and established the Graduate School in 1984. Upholding the SJTU tradition of "high starting point, solid foundation, strict requirement, emphasizing practice, and pursuing innovation, the Graduate School cultivated various kinds of excellent talents to meet the needs of the country. Hitherto, 80,861 Master or Doctor Degrees have been awarded to the graduate students.

SJTU has established a complete post-graduate education and degree-awarding system, offering degree programs at both the master & doctorate levels in various disciplines. Currently, there are 28,353 registered postgraduates, including 13,746 full-time master students, 7,782 part-time master students, and 6,274 full-time doctoral students. There is also a team of high quality faculties, including 42 academicians of Chinese Academy of Sciences or Chinese Academy of Engineering, 94 Thousand Talents Plan professors, 60 Thousand Youth Talents professors, 130 Chang Jiang Scholars, 107 winners of the National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars, 11 innovative research groups funded by the National Natural Science Foundation of China, and 21 innovative research teams funded by the Ministry of Education of China. Schedules of Summer School

The Graduate International Summer School will be held during the summer of 2017. The specific time arrangement varies with the programs. You can refer to the page on the corresponding programs for detailed information.

How to apply

For most of the programs, applications should be made through: http://apply.sjtu.edu.cn. The following materials may be needed:

- > A scanned copy of the information page of your passport. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months for the visa application.
- > ID photo (similar to a passport photo)
- > Curriculum vitae
- > Personal statement
- > Report of your past research experience (if available)
- > Language proficiency certificate (if available)

If your intended program has other requirements (eg., apply through emails, or another online application system), you need to follow the special requirements of that program.

Financial Support

Some programs offer financial support to cover partial of the traveling expenses. For detailed information, please visit the website of each program, or contact the program managers.

SJTU Graduate International Summer School will be conducted mainly on two campuses: Xuhui and Minhang. Students will be arranged in on-campus accommodation or hotels outside of the campus based on the program. Some programs will cover the accommodation cost. For details, please check the homepage of the corresponding program.

More information regarding to the accommodation reservation will be released after the students have been admitted to SJTU Graduate International Summer School.
