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About Internationalization at Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu

Having acknowledged that globalization has transformed the world into a "global village", LBUS has increased its efforts to adjust its educational offer to the new, international demand.

LBUS is part of the Erasmus+ program and over the time the university has developed more than 350 partnerships with universities from Europe and Asia. Every year there are about 150 international students coming to LBUS and about 200 going to partner universities, for a study or placement mobility.

Knowledge is global and research must transcend the national boundaries. International projects are being carried out by setting up organizing committees formed out of professors and students; the last edition of International Week proved again that internationalization is of the main preoccupations of the university staff. Also, the various International Summer Schools that took place in LBUS, made the internalization process fun and appealing for many students, Romanian and international alike.
