PROGRAMME

Spanish Language and Culture Courses designed for international students intending to start or continue their studies on Spanish Language at the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid, or for those who intend to take a term/year at any Spanish university and need to have a previous knowledge of Spanish communicative skills.

The programme is a 4-week course covering Spanish language and cultural components run by the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid during the month of July, combining language and culture face to face lessons with outdoor cultural activities

The programme includes:

- Spanish Language course run by experts in Spanish communication skills.
- Indoor/Outdoor Cultural Activities.
- Accommodation in the University Students Hall.

SPANISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMME

METHODOLOGY

The programme applies the Blended Learning methodology, which combines classroom face-to-face tuition with individual and group activities via the AVE (Virtual Spanish Classroom) programme. (Instituto Cervantes)

DURATION

One month course: 120 hours (4 weeks), divided as follows:

- Spanish Language and Culture lessons: 60 face-to-face hours
- Team work tutored activities: 10 hours
- Online individual activities: 30 hours
- Outdoor cultural activities: 20 hours.

LEVELS

The course offers the following levels according to the Common European Reference Framework for Languages (CERF):

- A1 (Breakthrough)
- A2 (Waystage)
- B1.1/ B1.2 (Threshold)
- B2 (Vantage)

Students will be required to take a level test at the start of the course.

- 11:00 – 11:30. - Break.
- 11:30 – 13:30. - Spanish Language face to face session.
