

Application for an exemption of tuition fees for international students due to a disability that severely impacts your studies according to article 6 par. 7 of the Act on Higher Education Fees of the State of Baden-Württemberg (Landeshochschulgebührengesetz, LHGebG)

From the winter semester 2017/18 on, higher education institutions in Baden-Württemberg will charge **tuition fees of EUR 1,500 per semester for international students**. According to section 3 LHGebG, international students who are no citizens of an EU or EEA member state and do not have a German university entrance qualification will have to pay tuition fees.

According to article 6 par. 7 LHGebG international students can be exempted upon application from the tuition fees for international students if they have **a disability that severely impacts their students according to Article 2 of Volume 9 of the Social Code**.

A disability according to article 2 of Volume 9 of the Social Code severely impacts your studies if there is a degree of disability of at least 50%.

Proof:

A disability that severely impacts your studies according to article 6 par. 7 LHGebG has to be proven by:

- A pass for the severely disabled by the "Versorgungsamt" in charge
- or**
- A medical attestation that confirms a disability that **severely** impacts your studies and the expected duration of said disability

Application deadline, form of the application and documents that have to be submitted

Please apply through the KIT Campus Management and upload this **signed application form** with either a **copy of a German pass for the severely disabled** or a **copy of the medical attestation** before the beginning of the lecture period: <https://campus.studium.kit.edu/english/requests/index.php>

Obligations to Cooperate

According to article 10 par. 1 sentence 3 LHGebG you are obliged to immediately inform us of any changes of conditions relevant to the exception, exemption from payment, or reduction, or declared in connection with the latter.

Please be aware: you can apply after the admission but before the start of the lecture period! We therefore recommend that you apply early with all the necessary proofs.

Payment of other charges for the enrollment and re-registration

For the enrollment and the re-registration, the following charges have to be paid even if you are exempt from the tuition fees for international students: the administrative charge, the charge for the Studierendenwerk and the charge for the students union. Electronic Process

At KIT, the fees are charged electronically. Messages and decisions associated with the collection of fees as well as information on administrative acts (notifications) are sent electronically to the email of your KIT-account. For this purpose, you were given access to your KIT-account as part of the application procedure. It is your responsibility to regularly check the emails and notifications from the university.

According to article 41, par. 2 of the Baden-Württemberg Administrative Procedure Act (LVwVfG), the electronically sent notification is deemed to have been announced on the fourth day upon dispatch.

Reimbursement

If your application is approved, previously paid tuition fees can be reimbursed for the duration of the approved exemption.
