OPTIONS FOR ADDITIONAL CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

Strasbourg is located close to three airports (Baden-Baden, Frankfurt Hahn, Euroairport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg) which offer low cost flights with Ryanair, Easyjet, Germanwings, Vo-lotea and Vueling. Shuttles or trains depart from Strasbourg for those airports in Germany and Switzerland. If you plan in advance, you can travel to London, Rome or Barcelona at a very low price.
