Immerse in Spanish language and culture

This 3 week program has both linguistic and sociocultural aspects, which allows students to be fully immersed in Spanish language and culture. The course will help students to adjust to university-level Spanish and give them tools to communicate effectively in their daily lives at UPNA and in Pamplona.

This is a 90-hour course (75 hours of classroom instruction and 15 hours in a language lab) over 3 weeks. The course is taught at a B1 level, and is aimed at students who wish to increase their knowledge of the Spanish language and to improve their linguistic skills in a first contact with the country. The course is worth 6 ECTS credits (3 U.S. credits), though students may be able to arrange for additional credit with their home institutions, given the large number of hours in the course.

The course is focused on grammatical matters, communicative activities and cultural aspects of the country. In addition to classroom time, visits to the Navarra Museum, the Pamplona Cathedral and the city markets, will allow to experience the essence of Navarra's Art, History and Gastronomy first hand.

The Bridge Course is an excellent pre-session addition to a semester of study at UPNA, and may be completed with a one week intensive course of Spanish, free of charge for exchange students, before the semester starts.
